- Interprets By-Laws to Architects, Engineers, Draughts-persons, and property developers and property owners
- Ensures that Building Plan fees paid are relative to proposed projects depicted on building plans and recommends payment of shortfalls where due.
- Tests Drain layers and Plumbers for licensing purposes in accordance with the relevant By-Laws and issues certificates.
- Inspects all construction works to ensure they conform to Model Building By-Laws.
- Originates, recommends and issues certificates of occupation to public and private buildings.
- Stops construction of illegal structures.
