Responsible for all the planned maintenance activities related to all Council plant, equipment and machinery to ensure optimum plant availability and life span as well as maintain and update all records pertaining to plant installations, plant and equipment data, plant and equipment history of repairs.

- Prepares and distributes Planned Maintenance Schedules for all Council machinery and equipment to all the implementing agents.
